

# Lionel Gabriel Lang

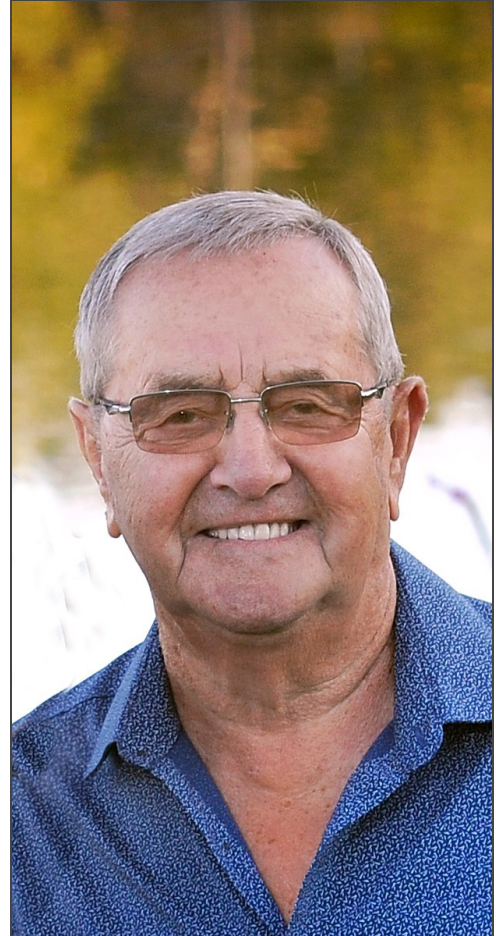
