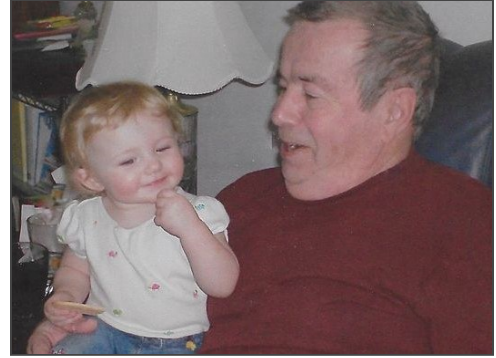


Alfred (Frenchy) Larochelle
