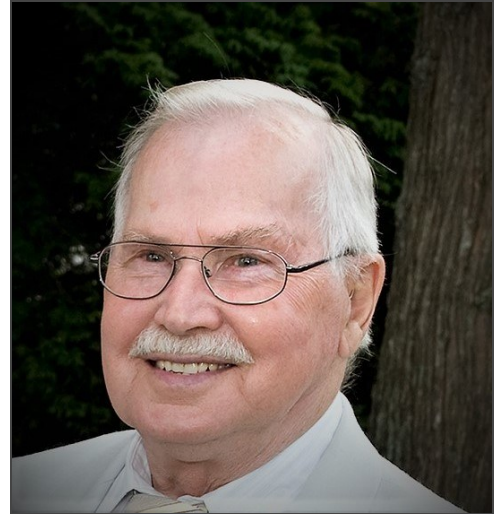


Daniel William Laskey
