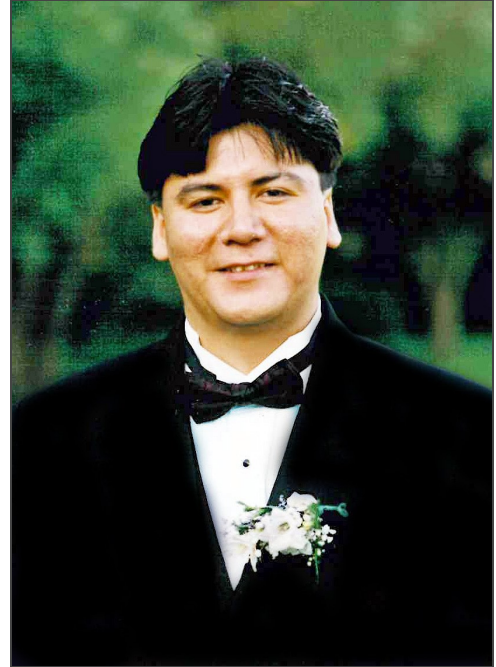


Alvis Adair Lavallee
