

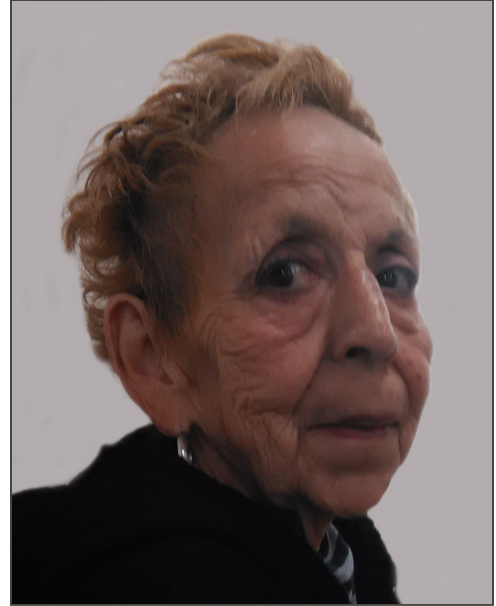
Alvina Mary Lewis
