

Robert John Lidster

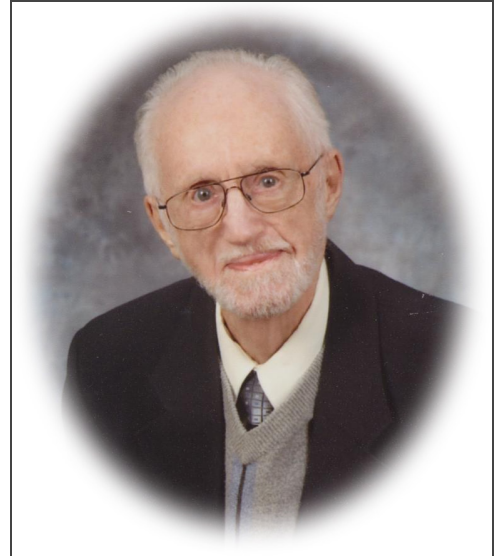
