Pre-deceased by her husband of more than 70 years Bruce, who is waiting to take her on in their 11,000th game of crib, and survived by her five children - Doug, Dave, Lynn, Joan and John - along with their spouses and her 15 grandchildren and 27 great-grandchildren (soon to be 29), Mom leaves a true legacy of love and unwavering support. We miss her already while strengthened with a clear sense that she lives on in our hearts and souls.
