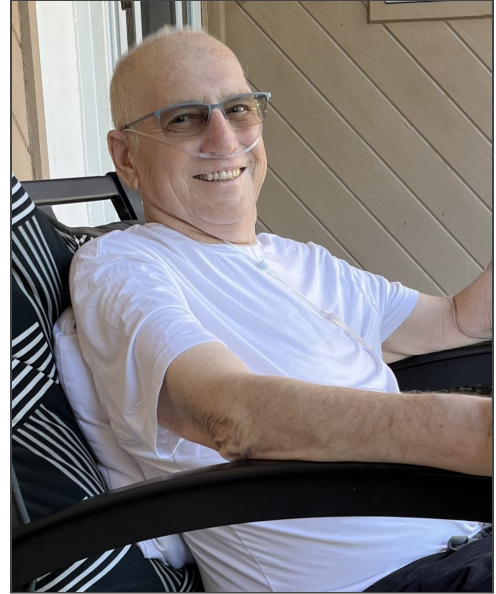
Dale Alfred Loney, late of Regina, Saskatchewan, passed away at home after a long and courageous battle with cancer at the age of 72.
