Lorie was also deeply proud of her involvement with the Coalition Against No-Fault Insurance, where she passionately advocated for the rights of those affected and worked to make a meaningful difference in others' lives.

The family would like to express their sincere gratitude to the doctors, nurses, and staff who cared for Lorie throughout her illness and during her final days. A special thank you is extended to Lorie's sister-in-law and dear friend, Angie, for her unwavering support, love, and presence when it was needed most.
