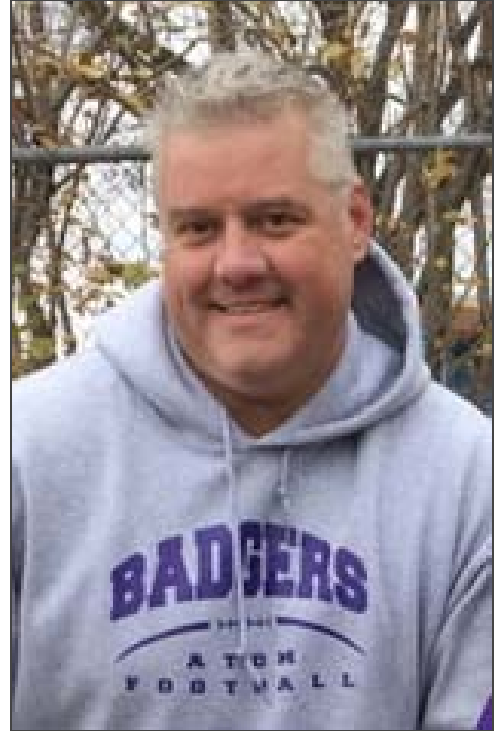


Denis Losie

On September 5, 2020 Denis Losie died peacefully as a result of liver failure with family by his side. Denis was 46 years old and lived and struggled with an alcohol addiction, a beast of a disease, for longer than many were aware. Born on November 18, 1973, Denis was a gentle and kind soul from day one. Denis is survived by his mother Donna; sisters Alexis and Maureen (Zevin); Jenny and sons Luke, Jake, and Ben; as well as a large group of extended family and friends. He was predeceased by his grandparents Jim and Marjorie Losie and Alex and Patricia Unser; brother in infancy; daughter Lily; and father Denis Losie Sr. Denis was passionate about his work, sports, the outdoors, and quality time spent with those he loved.
