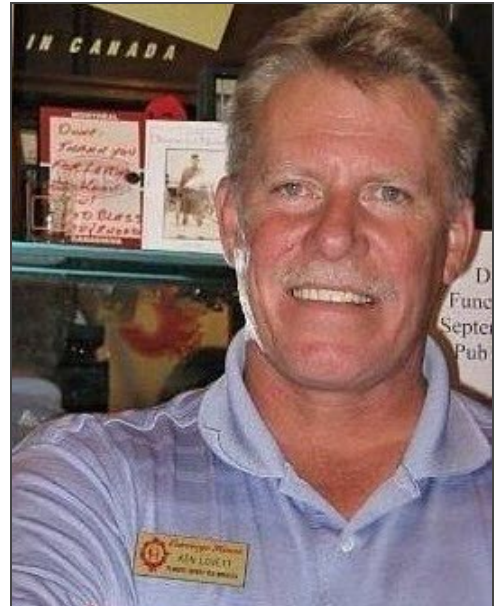


# Kenneth David Lovett
