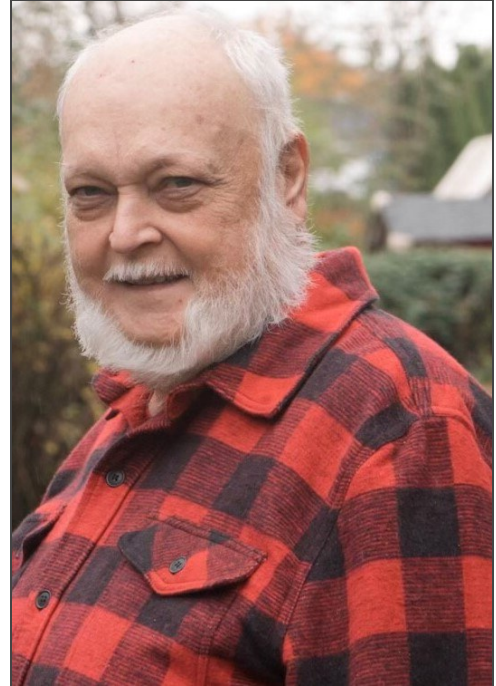


Robert Arthur Lowden
