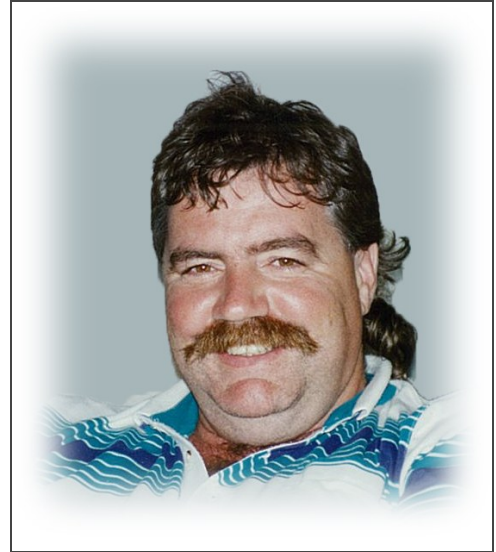


Terrell Duncan MacKenzie
