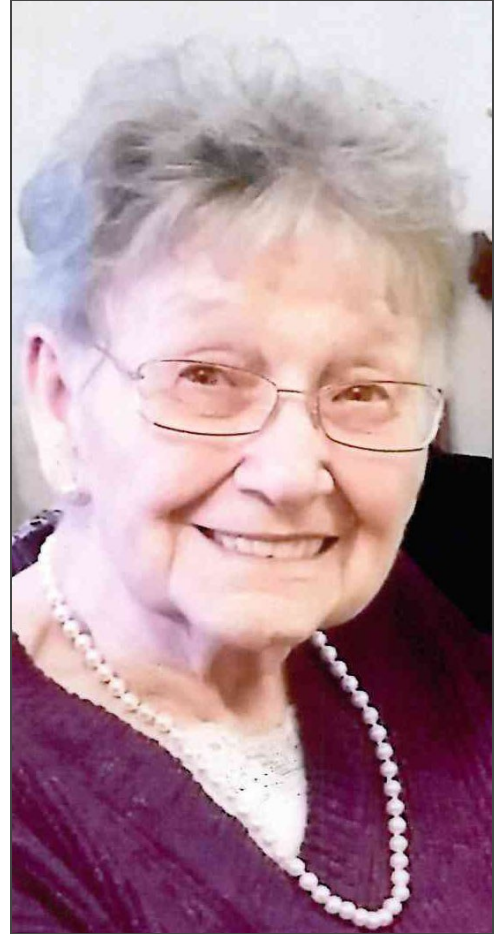


Erna Julianna Manz
