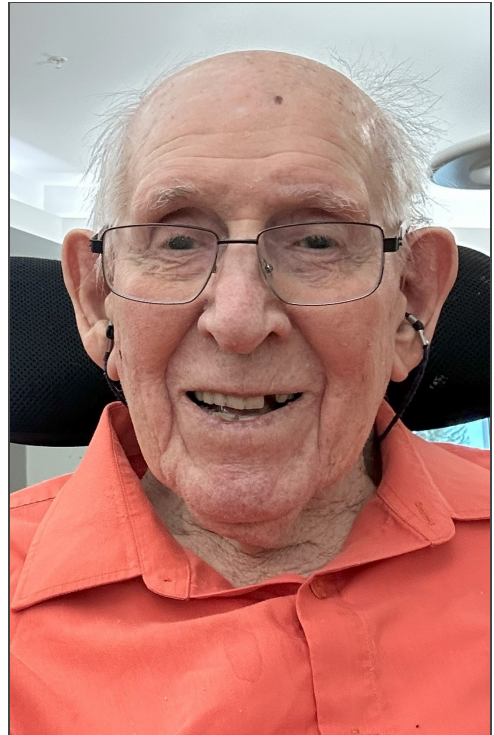


# Marinus Johannes Van Gaans
