Thomas "Tom" Donald McCallum passed away on Wednesday, October 10, 2018 at his farm near Carstairs, AB. Tom is lovingly remembered by his brothers, Clifford (Jean), Elmer (Donna), Angus (Donna); sister, Phyllis (Bob) Hunter; nieces and nephews, Patti, Melanie, Jason, Jackie, Meghan, Brett and Erin. He was predeceased by his parents, Archie and Mary; and niece, Danielle. He was born on April 11, 1951 in Boissevain, MB. Tom took his schooling at Primrose and Boissevain to Grade 10.
