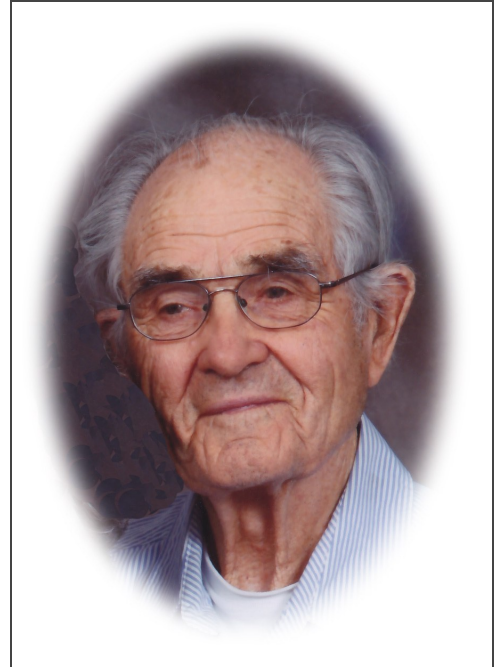


Roy Archie McDermand
