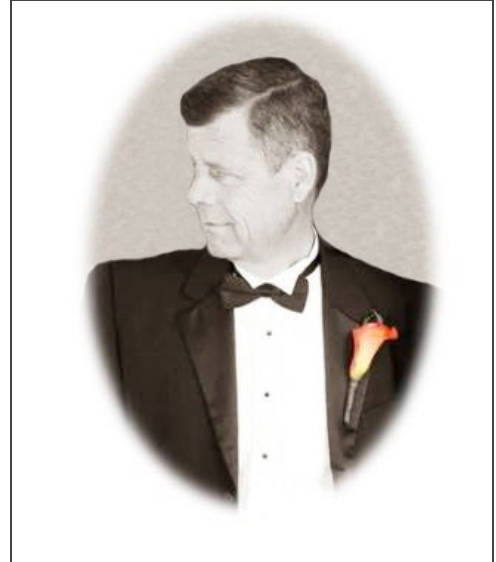


R. "Eric" Eric McDermott
