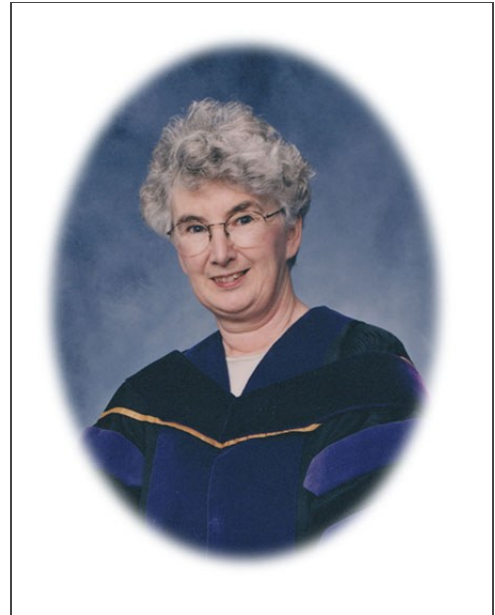
April 4, 1941 - October 10, 2014
