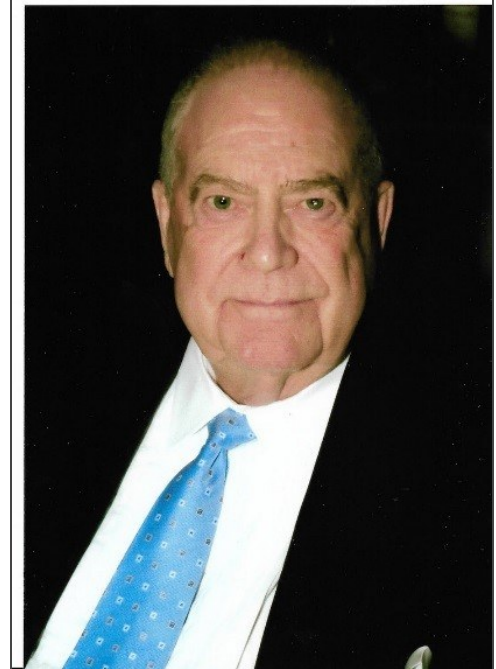


Michael "Mike" Mulligan McMahon
