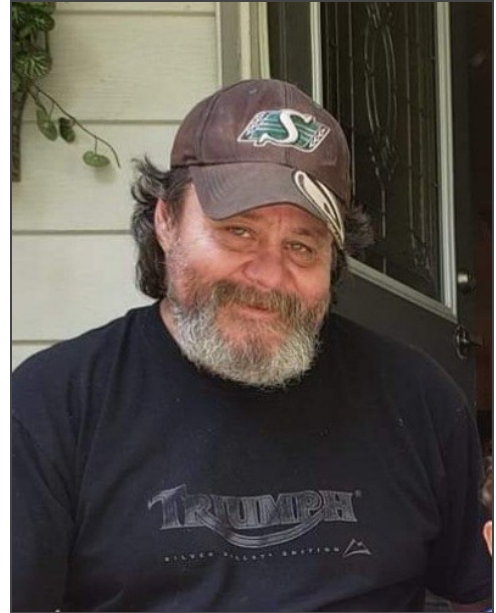


Gordie Floyd McMurdo
