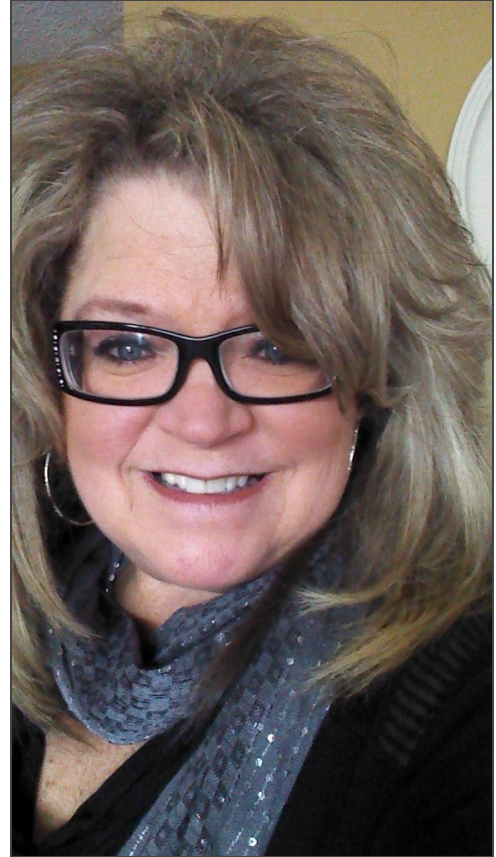


Debra Ann Mitchell
