

Samuel Robert Moffett

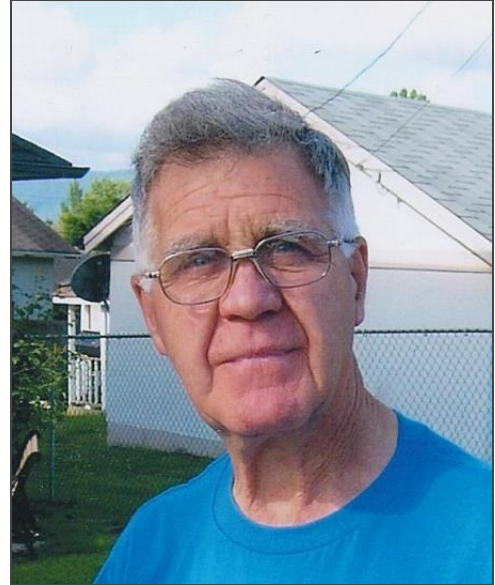
