Russ passed away peacefully at the Pasqua Hospital on March 18, 2016 at Regina, Saskatchewan, just shy of his 80th birthday. He was born on the farm at Kelliher, Saskatchewan on May 19, 1936.

Russ loved his family, playing cards, music, farming, fishing, golfing, snowmobiling, curling, and driving his motorhome. Some of his favourite holidays were at Waskesiu, Deschambault, Shell, and Last Mountain lakes and travelling south for short winter vacations.
