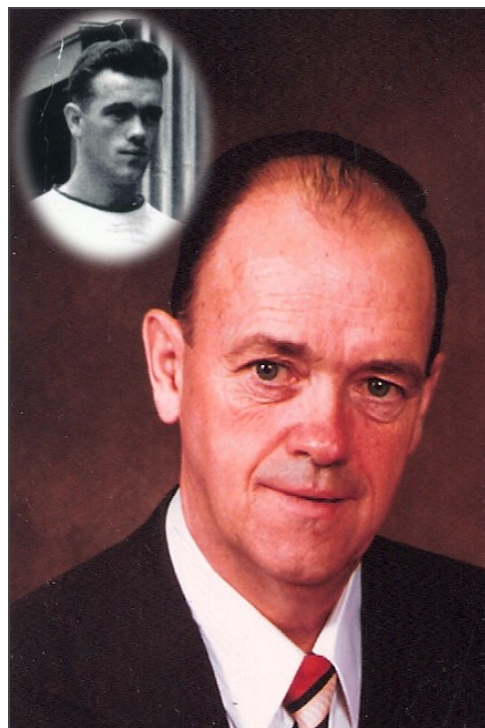


John "Jack" Dawson Molyneux
