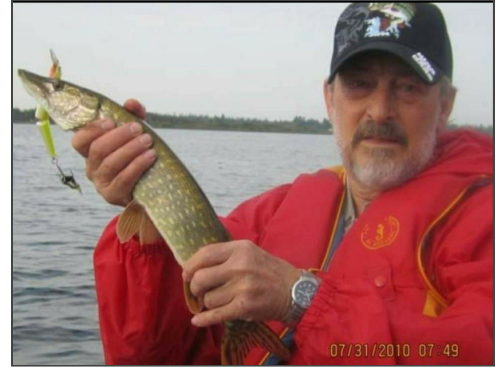


Robert Sheridan Montgomery

Montgomery on Friday, May 12, 2023 with his daughter by his side at the age of 80.

Robert (aka Bob) was born on May 12, 1943 to Joseph Montgomery and Eva Montgomery (Sheridan) in Vancouver British Columbia. Later his family moved to Portage LA Prairie, Manitoba where he grew up. On September 5, 1969 he married his wife of 53 years, Eileen Montgomery (Zinn). They raised their two children Marshal and Marlis in Regina, Saskatchewan.

Robert is predeceased by his parents and wife. home with which he had much pride in. Robert was a blunt multifaceted man but at the core, loving and devoted to his family. He enjoyed taking them on fishing trips, skiing, golfing and helping out at Eileen's family's farm with whatever he could.

In his later years he enjoyed watching football and curling with his wife as she was also an avid sports fan. His favorite shows were The Curse of Oak Island and Ancient Aliens which he would stay up late to watch. He was looking forward to spring and summer to sit on his deck. After the passing of his wife, he and his daughter were going to attempt to grow a garden as his wife had done. They were experimenting with various garden techniques and he was eager to see the results.

He had a very special bond with his great-grand daughter Willow. They would play little games of hide and seek, "got your toe", or just dance to nursery rhymes. Every time she came through the front door he would greet her "Hey you!"

The family would like to express their gratitude to the friends and family who supported and spent time with him through the passing of his wife in September of 2022, for the past 8 months and during his 3 week stay at the hospital.
