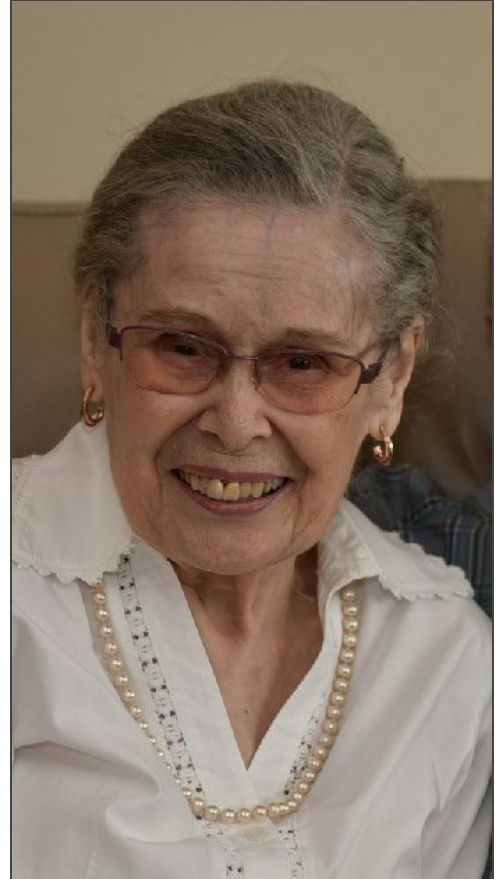


Fernande Montpetit
