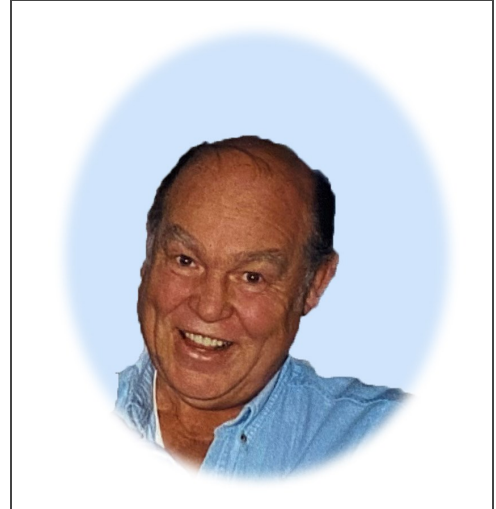


# Donald Francis Moon
