

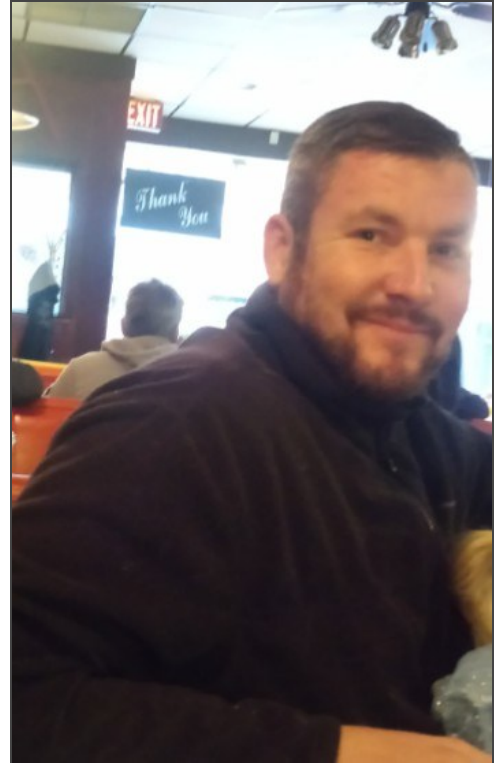
# John George Moore
