

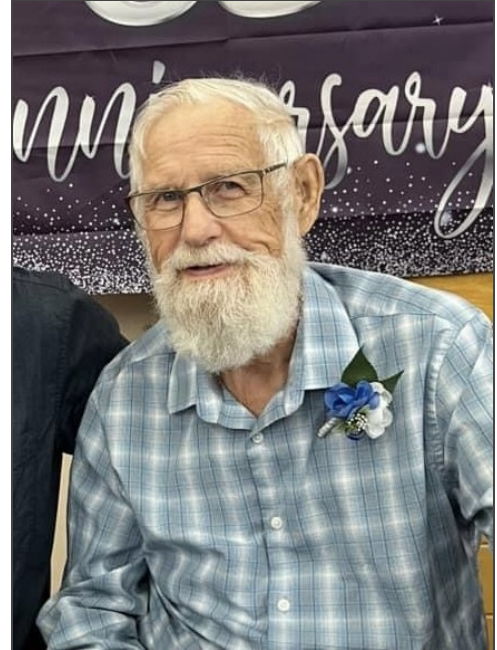

Robert (Bob) Arthur Moore, late of Regina, passed away peacefully on September 2, 2024, at age 88.
