Ralph and Norma were residents of St. Andrews Heights for over 35 years, raising the family there and having some of the best neighbors and friends. There were several neighborhood parties over the years where Norma would play the piano while Ralph crooned.

Ralph and Norma spent many hours volunteering for community activities. Ralph was predeceased by Norma in July 2007, his wife of over 50 years. We are at comfort knowing that they have been reunited once again.
