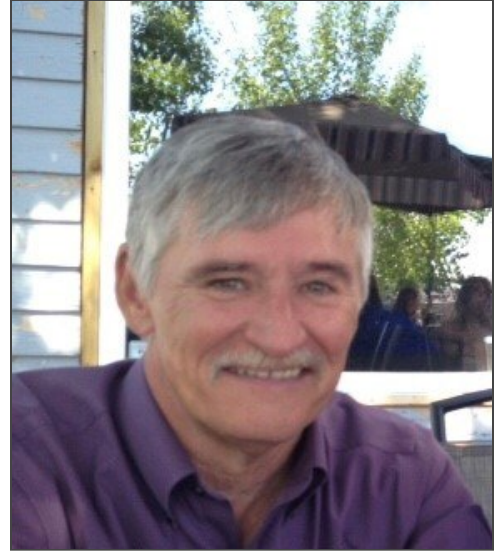
together; daughters, Kyla Morris and Jody
