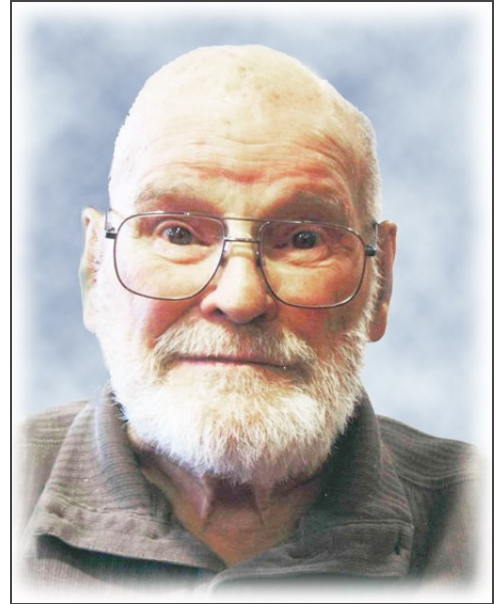


# Wesley David Morris
