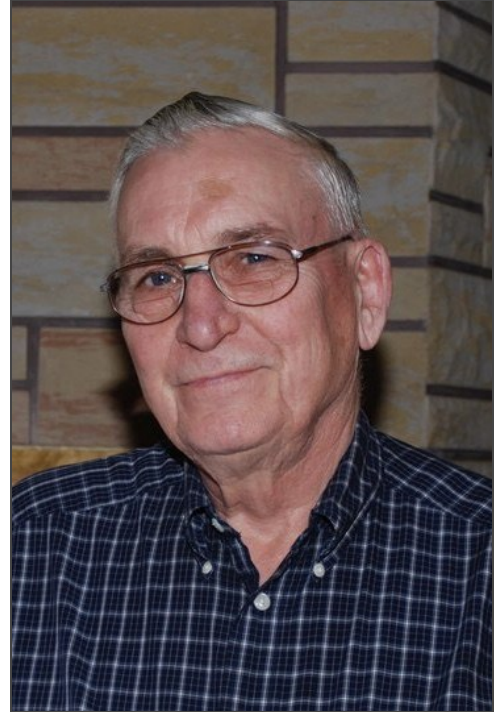
Jim Morrison, son, brother, husband, father, uncle, grandfather, great-grandfather and friend, passed away on December 23, 2022.
