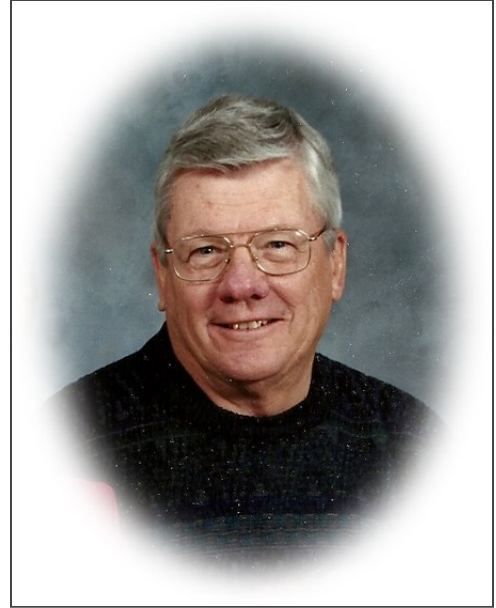


# Peter Charles Moss
