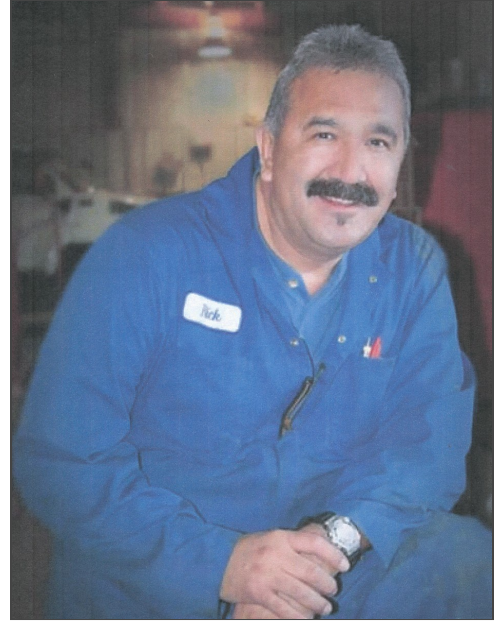


Richard "Rick" Gerald Mousseau
