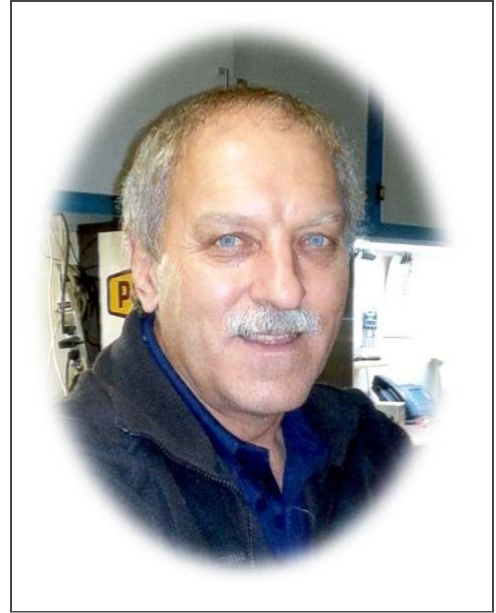


Denis Steve Muehmel
