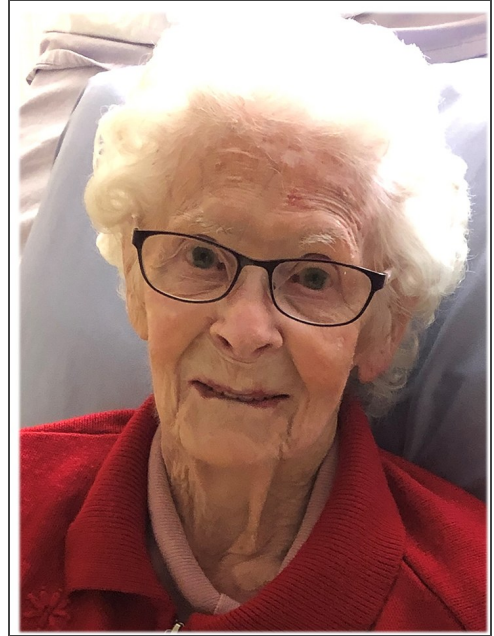


# Gladys Eilene Muir
