It is with heavy hearts that we announce the peaceful passing of Murray Wiens on July 24, 2026, at the age of 74.

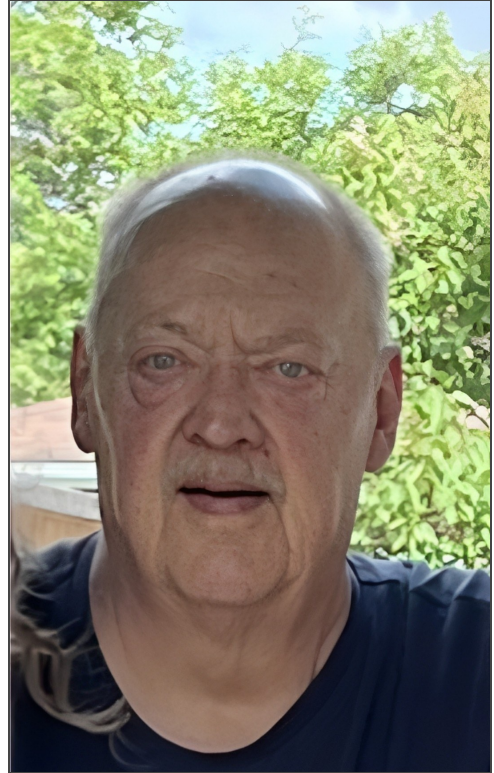
Murray shared nearly 53 wonderful years of marriage with the love of his life, Leslie.
