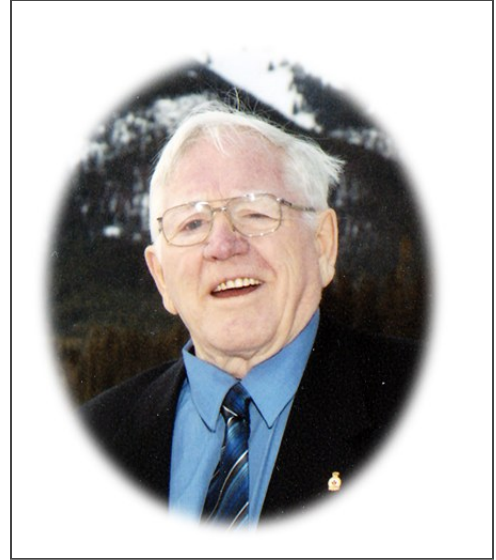


John Dorr Nelson
