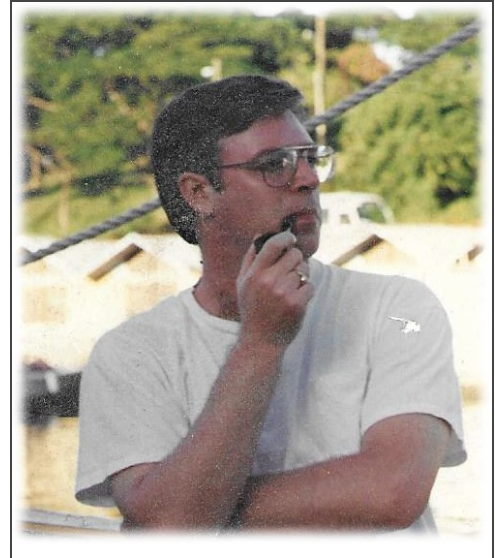
NESBITT, Robert Allan
