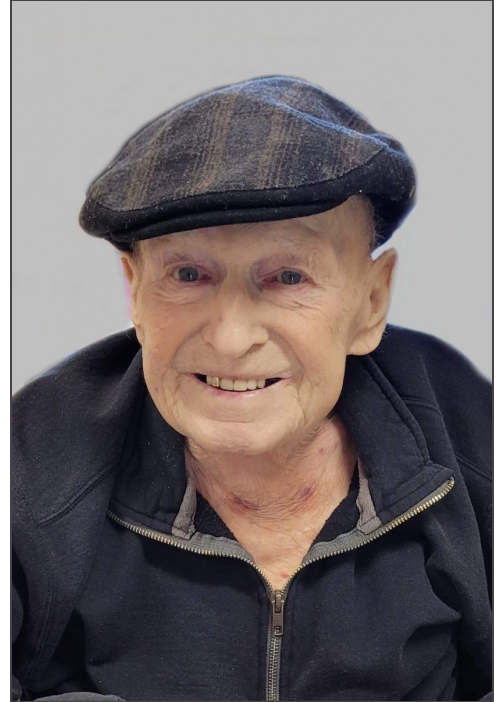


Joseph Newby
