It is with deep sadness the family of Rod Newby announces his death on October 13, 2023.

Rod is survived by his wife Emi, sister Ann (Haig) and their children Ari, Sarah (Thomas) and Emma (Jake), his mother-in-law Fujiko, sisters-in-law Michi (Don), their children Kai and Kira, Yuriko (Jason) their child Brandon, and Tomoko (Ian) their children Devyn and Chayce. He was predeceased by his parents, Jim and Joan and his father-in-law Ken.
