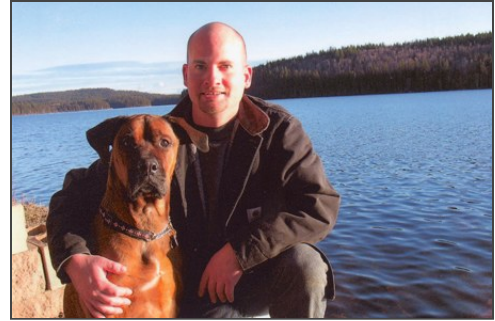


Clifton Jeffrey Noiles
