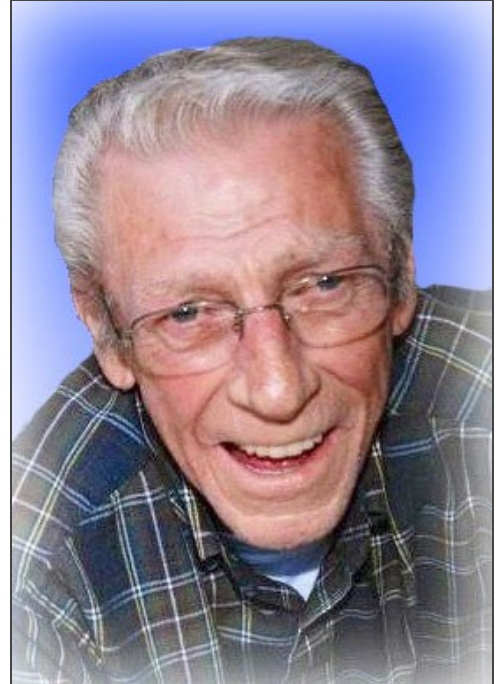


# Kenneth James Norton
