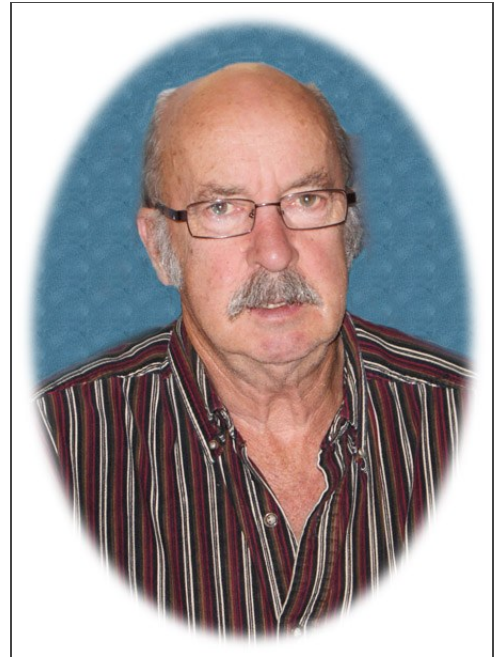


George Edward Olsen
