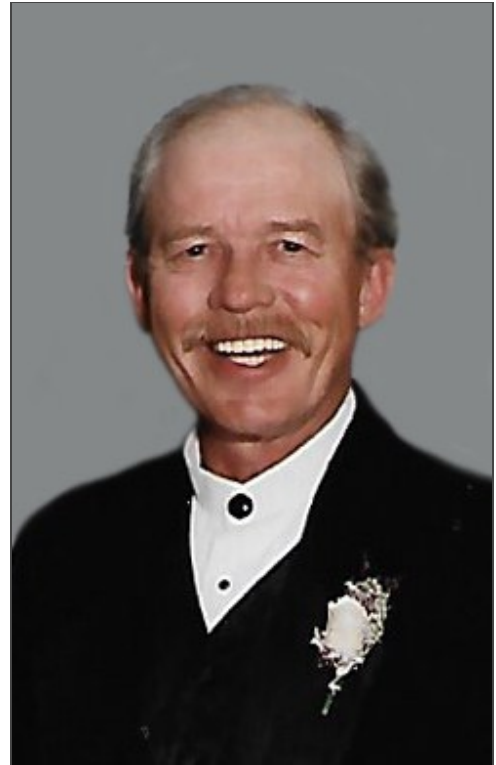


Ronnie Joseph Olynick
