

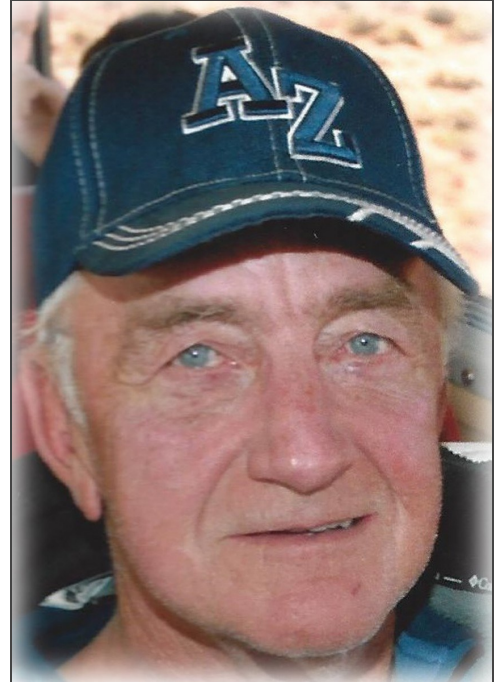
Ronald Allen Opp
