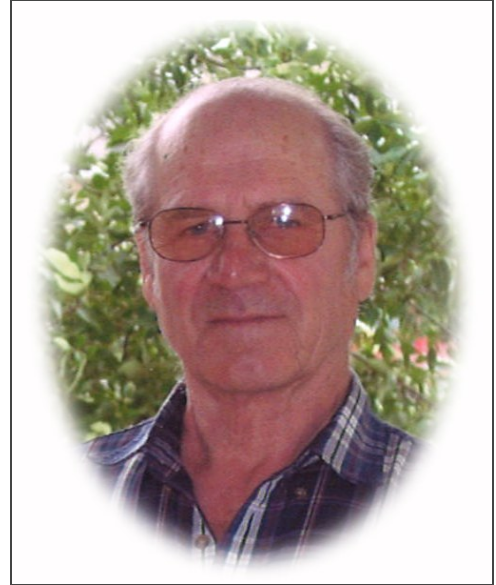


# Gilbert Andrew Osborne
