On April 9, 2019 Babe passed away after a battle with cancer at the age of 83.

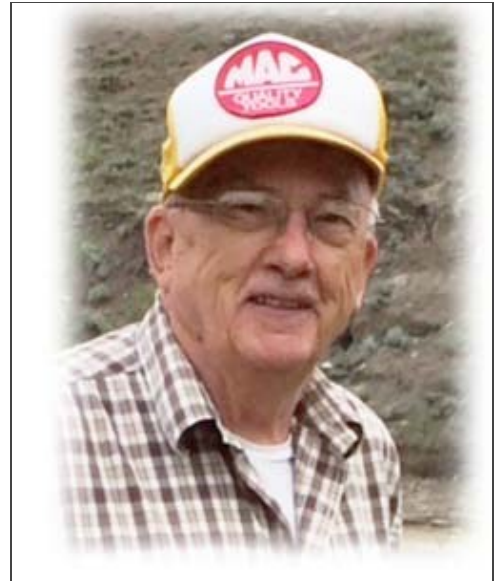
